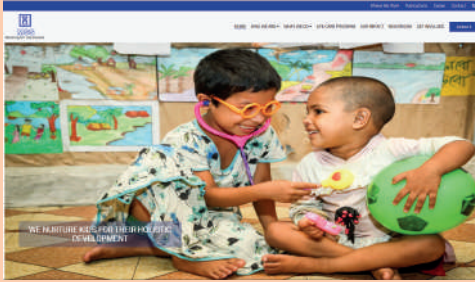


Welcome to the new look of MSS Website
