## **EYE CARE HELPLINE (ECH):**

The ECH continue to provide eye care service through audio and video calls so that patients can avoid hospital/clinic visits and stay Covid-19 safe. Till June 30, ECH provided treatment to 795 patients. Among them 400 patients were male and 395 female. Medicines were prescribed to 431 patients.

These patients came from 37 districts of Bangladesh.The highest number of patients came from Dhaka (374), Rajshahi (118), Natore (44), Thakurgaon (30), Pabna (30), Panchagarh (24), Bogura (30) and Saidpur (21).

## **DOORSTEPS EYE CARE:**

During June 2021, seven "Doorsteps Eye Care" (DEC) camps were conducted with "Noyon Tori" at different locations of Thakurgaon and Panchagarh. At these camps, a total of 955 patients were screened. One hundred fifty-eight cataract patients were identified while 130 patients underwent surgery at Shafiuddin Ahmed Foundation (SAF) Hospital, a partner hospital situated in Thakurgaon. The remaining patients will be operated at the SAF hospital during July 2021.

ECP introduced its DEC program to provide eye care services for the underprivileged people at their doorstep. DEC is currently focusing on remote and rural areas of Thakurgaon and Panchagarh districts. Beneficiaries include MSS microcredit members, their families and local community people. Under the DEC program - Noyon Tori – the mobile eye clinic goes into remote rural areas and provides eye care services to community at their doorstep.

Our DEC camps are currently suspended due to Covid-19 driven shutdown and will open soon as situation permits.
