EYE CAMPS:

Eleven public eye camp was conducted in five districts Panchagarh, Dinajpur, Rangpur, Chapai, and Rajshahi at 8 different Upazelas by the Eye Care Program of Manabik Shahajya Sangstha (ECP-MSS) with the technical assistance of Shafiuddin Ahmed Foundation (SAF) Hospital, Rangpur Eye Hospital, Rangpur, and Prof. Matin BNSB Base Eye Hospital, Sirajganj, and Makka Eye Hospital, Rajshahi in May 2023.

At these camps, comprehensive eye care services were provided to 3280 underserved people by qualified doctors, technicians, and modern eye screening equipment. Patients were issued prescriptions. Free spectacles were given out to 845 patients. Cataract was identified in 872 patients. Surgeries were successfully performed on 682 patients at the partner hospitals.

EYE CARE CAMPAIGN AT BGMEA:

One eye care campaign was conducted at BGMEA Complex in Uttara on May 28 and 29. BGMEA President Mr. Faruque Hasan inaugurated the event. Earlier, a presentation on ECP was made to BGMEA members, staff, and journalists.

During the event, doctors conducted basic eye tests to identify problems and prescribed eyeglasses and medicines. ECP also arranged an audio-visual awareness presentation where eye health-related advice and guidance were highlighted.

Under this eye camp, ECP provided comprehensive eye care services to 285 employees (including 20 journalists) through qualified doctors, technicians, and modern eye screening equipment. Thirty-seven readings and 16 custom-made spectacles were given out to the patients.

AMBULANCE HANDOVER:
